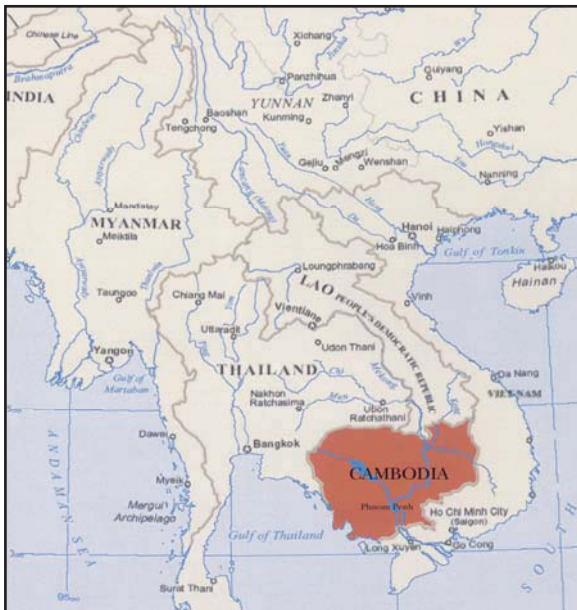

## Khmer History

The Mon-Khmer race developed slowly during the first six centuries of the Christian era. Under Indian influence, a powerful maritime empire called “Funan” ruled over all the shores of the Gulf of Siam. Within a short time, this new power known as Chenla absorbed the Funanese Kingdom. In the late 7<sup>th</sup> century, Chenla broke into two parts: land Chenla (to the north) and water Chenla (to the south along the Gulf of Thailand). Land Chenla was fairly stable during the 8<sup>th</sup> century, whereas water Chenla was beset by dynastic rivalries.

At the beginning of the 9<sup>th</sup> century, the kings set up their capital in the present province of Siem Reap. For nearly six centuries, they erected two hundred temples as well as their sanctuaries in the Angkorian area of some 400 square kilometers in the Siem Reap Province.

King Suryavarman II (1113-1150) built the temples such as Angkor Wat, Thommanon, Chau Say Tevoda, Preah Palilay, Preah Pithu, and Banteay Samrè.

Jayavarman VII (1181-1220) was best known for his huge building program. Firstly, he built Ta Prohm (1186) and Preah Khan (1191) to dedicate to his parents. Secondly, he erected Banteay Kdei, Srah Srang, the Terrace of the Leper King, the Terrace of the Elephants, Neak Pean, Ta Som, Ta Nei, and some others in other parts of the country. Thirdly, he founded his great capital, Angkor Thom. Finally, in the center, he built the Bayon with its two hundred stone faces.

The decline of the Angkor era began after the death of King Jayavarman VII in the early 13<sup>th</sup> century. Due to the Siamese invasion and the limitation of the irrigation system, Khmer power declined so much that the king was finally obliged to move to the vicinity of Phnom Penh in 1431. Resulting from a series of Siamese and Cham invasions, the country was put as a French protectorate in 1863.

After regaining Independence in 1953, the country has had several names:

1. The Kingdom of Cambodia (under the Reachia Niyum Regime from 1953 to 1970);
2. The Khmer Republic (under the Lon Nol Regime from 1970 to 1975);
3. Democratic Kampuchea (under the Pol Pot Genocidal Regime from 1975 to 1979);
4. The People’s Republic of Kampuchea (1979-1989);
5. The State of Cambodia (1989-1993);
6. The Kingdom of Cambodia (1993 until now).

# MANAGING ENVIRONMENT IMPACTS

---

Several environmental management policies and impact control measures, as they relate to tourism, should be applied, as follows:

Plan and develop tourism based on the concept of not exceeding the logical carrying capacity of the environment. That is, not overloading the environment with excessive tourism development or visitor use that will lead to environmental degradation.

Installation of proper infrastructure for tourism development areas, including potable water supply, non-polluting electric power, and effective sewage collection, treatment and disposal, solid waste collection and drainage systems.

Development of adequate road and other transportation systems in tourism areas.

Provision of open space and parks and generous use of landscaping in tourism areas.

Integrated land use planning of tourism areas, appropriate location of tourist facilities and application of suitable development standards.

Careful management of visitor use and flows at national parks, wildlife sanctuaries and other protected areas and archaeological and historic sites so that these places will not be damaged or degraded by excessive visitor use or vandalism by visitors.

Control of littering of the landscape by tourists and residents through public and tourist education, and placement of litter receptacles in public places.

Proper maintenance of tourist vehicles so that they do not generate undue air pollution or noise.

Control on taking or killing of endangered wild animal species and collection of scarce species of plant and marine life.

Sustainable management of forest resources with prohibition of logging in protected areas.

Maintenance of environmental health and safety standards for both residents and tourists including control of environmentally-derived diseases.

Adoption of the environmental law and application of the environmental impact assessment procedures to tourist facilities (as well as other types of development).



## Executive Summary

Cambodia's tourism industry continued to grow in 2006, with international arrivals peaking at **1,700,041**, an increase of **19.59%** over the 2005 figure of 1,421,615 (number; international arrivals in 2005). The peak months were December (214,665 arrivals, 12.63% of total arrivals), November (163,068 arrivals, 9.59% of total arrivals), January (163,047 arrivals, 9.59% of total arrivals), February (151,821 arrivals, 8.93% of total arrivals) and March (142,437 arrivals, 8.38% of total arrivals) followed by August (132,792 arrivals, 7.81% of total arrivals).

Earnings from tourism increased to US\$ **1,049** million, a growth of **26.08%** over 2005.

### Mode of Arrivals:

#### Arrivals by Air

The 1,027,064 international arrivals by air which is a share of 60.41% of the total international arrivals in Cambodia, Siem Reap International Airport accounted for 35.27%. Thus 599,675 international visitors arrived through the airport, which is 36.25% more than in 2005 and accounted for 58.36% of arrivals by air in the country.

International arrivals to Phnom Penh International Airport accounted for 25.14% of total arrivals. Therefore 427,389 international visitors arrived through Phnom Penh, which represents a share of 41.60% of arrivals by air in the country.

Most of international visitors flew via Bangkok (19.44%), Singapore (12.22%), Kuala Lumpur (2.90%), Ho Chi Minh City (19.44%) and others (44.01%).

#### Arrivals by Land and Boat

The number of international arrivals through land and water border check points increased from 476,479 in 2005 to 564,286 in 2006 accounting for 33.19% of all international arrivals in Cambodia in 2006, increase 18.43% compared over 2005. The most important border check point was Poi Pet with 284,597 international arrivals (50.43% of arrivals at land border check points) followed by Bavet 119,980 (21.26%), Cham Yeam 22,576 (4.00%), Daung 68,161 (12.08%), Sihanoukville 63,556 (4.50%) increase 34.33%, Kaamsamnor 31,307 (5.55%) and other check points 36,171 (6.41%).

The number of excursionists through the Preah Vihear land border check point from Thailand reached 108,691 which is 22.66% more than in 2005.

#### Purpose of Visit

Holiday is the main reason to visit Cambodia. For 79.51% of international tourists, the main purpose was holiday followed by business 5.33%, official travel 4.41%, visiting friends and relatives 4.83% and others 5.92%.

#### Visitor Profile

Males accounted for 55.07% of all international visitors.

Occupation: Majority of visitors were business people (16.54%) followed by employees (16.96%), teachers and students (25.86%), retired (8.84%) and others (32.16%).

### Travel/Trip Profile

The average length of stay in 2006 was 6.50 days. During the stay in Cambodia, international visitors spent US\$ 95.00 an average per day.

Majority of international visitors were FIT (free independent travelers) travelers in 2006. FIT travelers accounted for 40.85% and GIT (group inclusive travel) travelers for 59.15% of all international visitors in 2006.

Of all international arrivals, 50.38% visited the Siem Reap Angkor Complex and 49.62% visited Phnom Penh in 2006.

### Source Markets

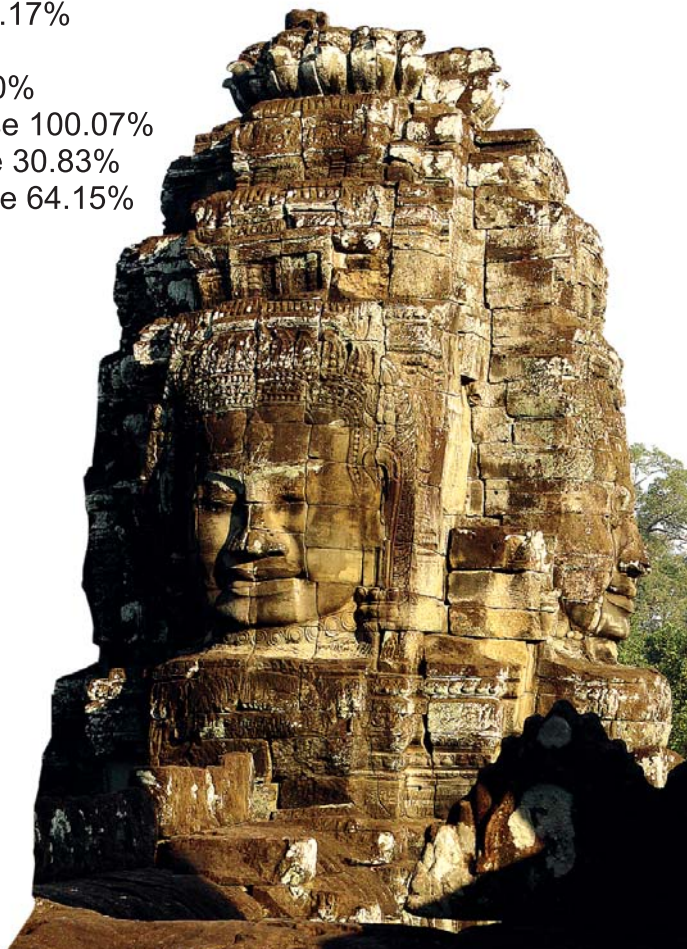
Based on arrival volumes, the Republic of Korea was the major source market for Cambodia, providing 16.79% of the total 285,353 visitors in 2006. The next most important source markets were Japan (9.31%), U.S.A (7.28%), Taiwan (5.01%), China (4.74%), Vietnam (4.56%), Malaysia (4.53%), Thailand (4.53%), United Kingdom (4.34%), and France (4.23%).

In terms of growth amongst the major source markets, it was the Ten market that exhibited the strongest growth (up by 27.06% over 2005) followed by Malaysia 77,028 (108.88%), Vietnam 77,524(56.17%) and Taiwan 85,139 (55.45%).

### Domestic Market

The number of domestic tourists is estimated at 7.76 Million, an 47.03% increase compared over 2005 (5,278,113).

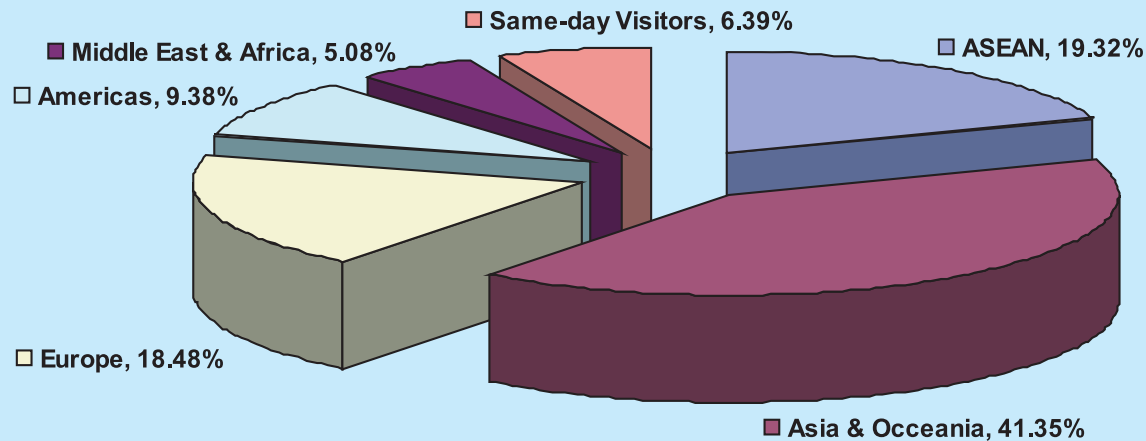

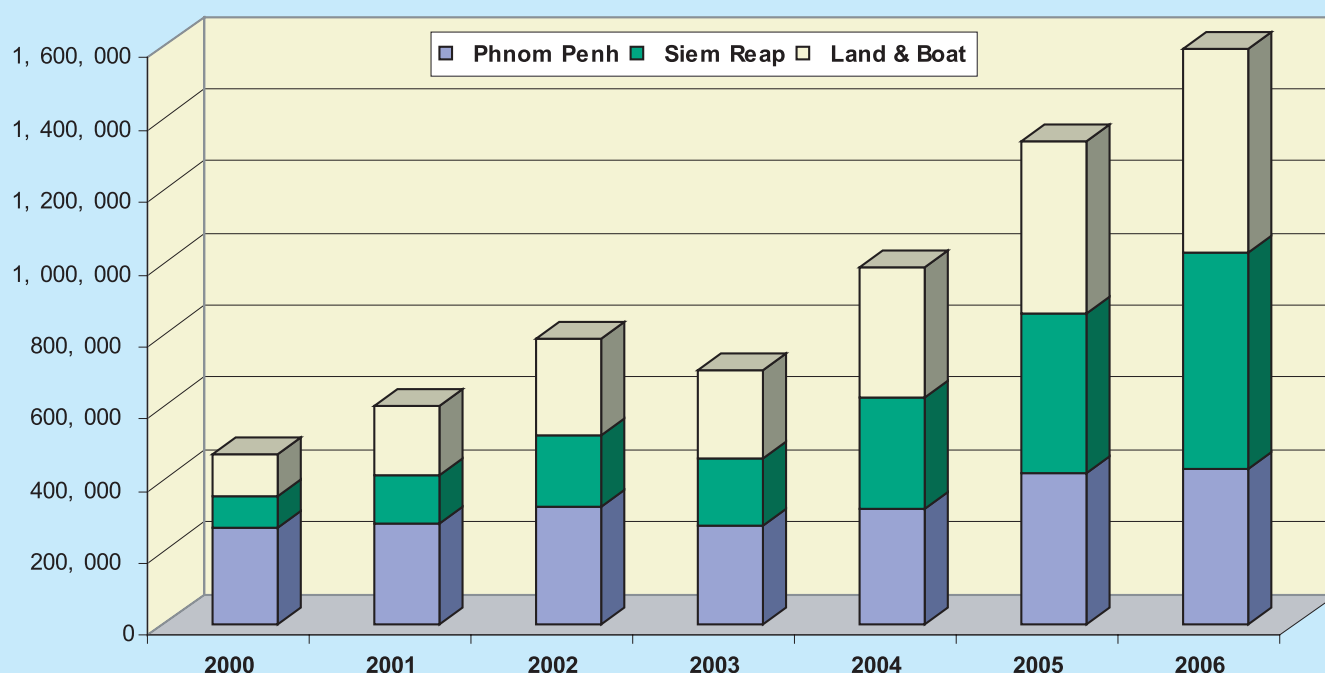

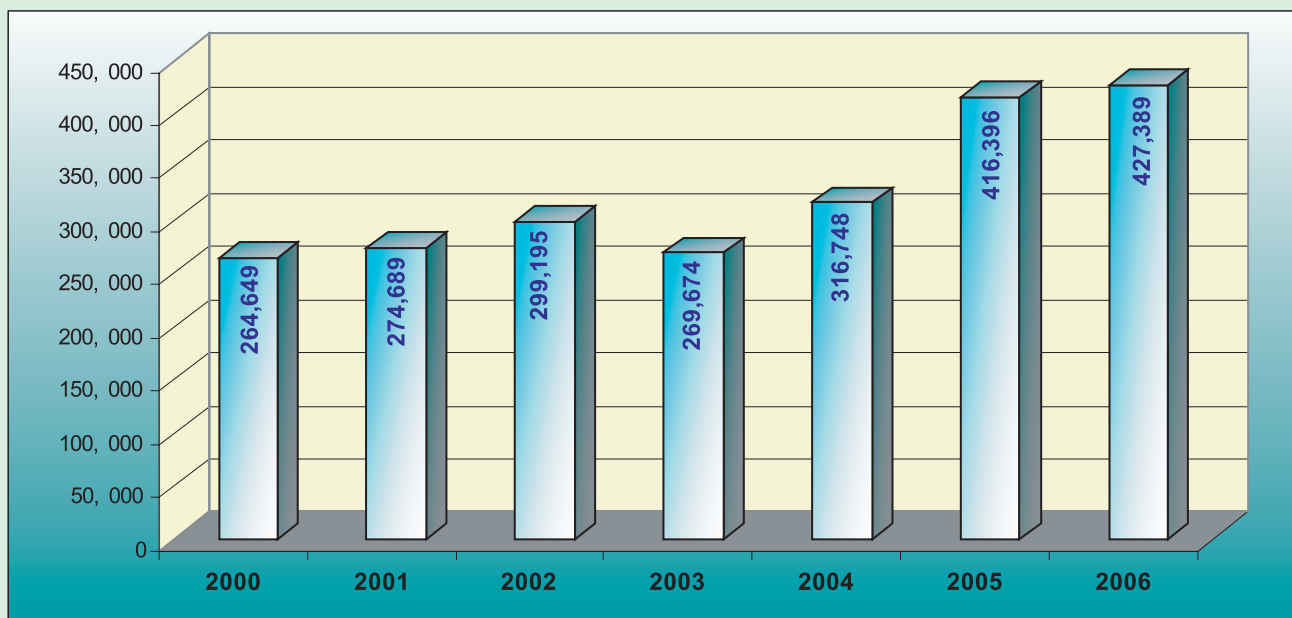

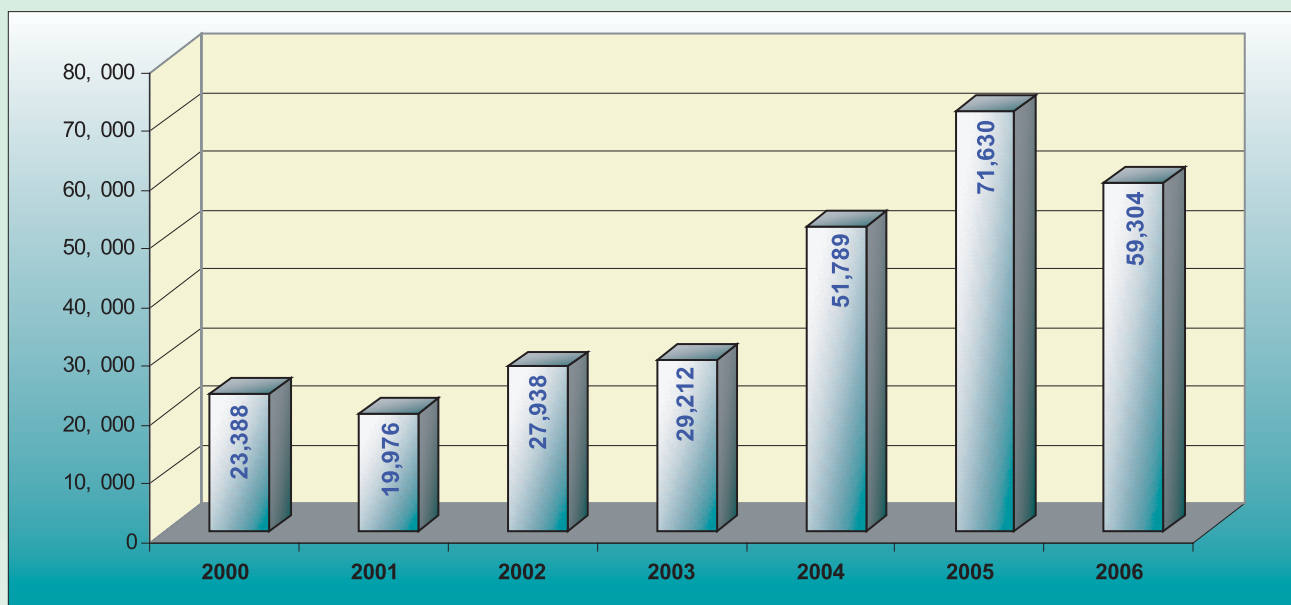

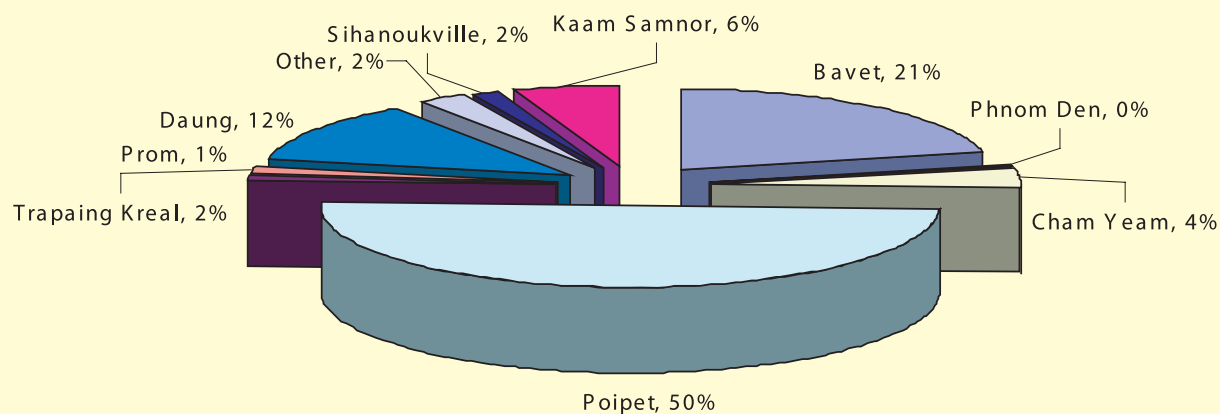

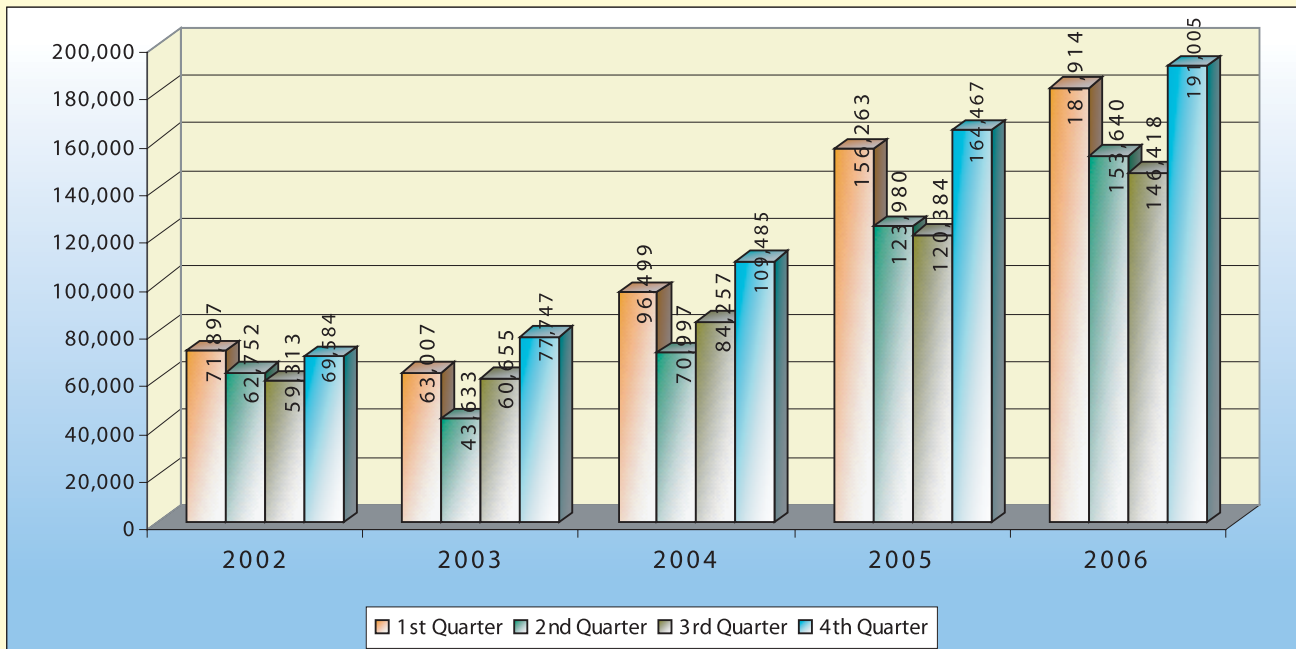

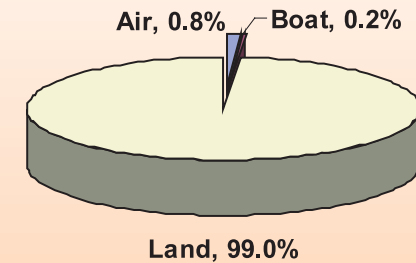

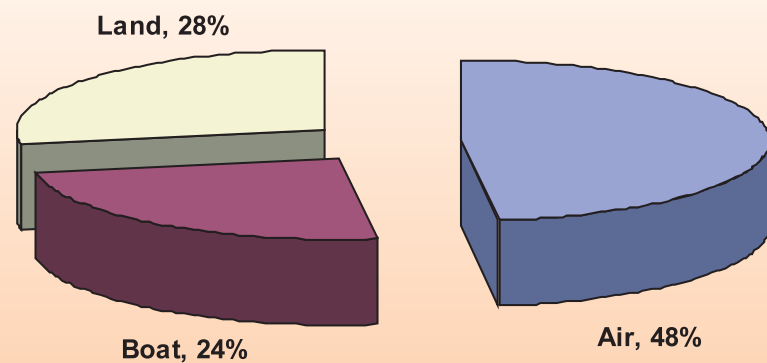

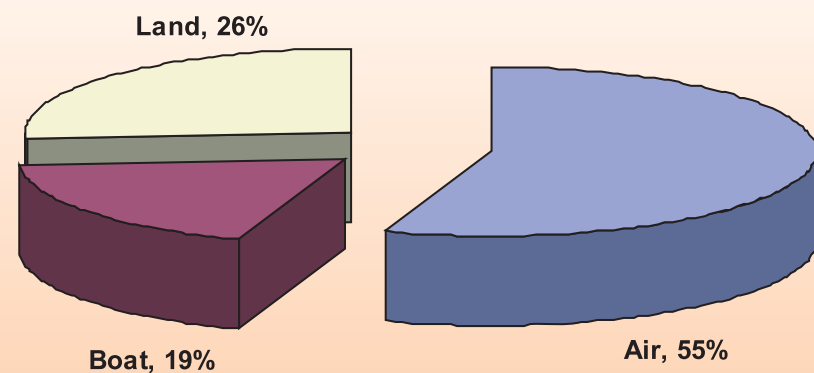
